Leven appears on the NC Census of 1784-1787 living in Wilkes Co. and is also shown on the county Tax List. The 1790 Federal Census has Lenvil Cole (probably a misspelling) in the same county. Levin purchased land at Nathans Creek in 1786 which he sold in 1790. He appears on the Madison Co., KY Tax list in 1794 and on Jan. 1, 1799,

he purchased land on Silver Creek. He sold this property in 1804 and purchased land in St. Louis Co., MO in 1805. He lived in MO until his death in 1816.³
